

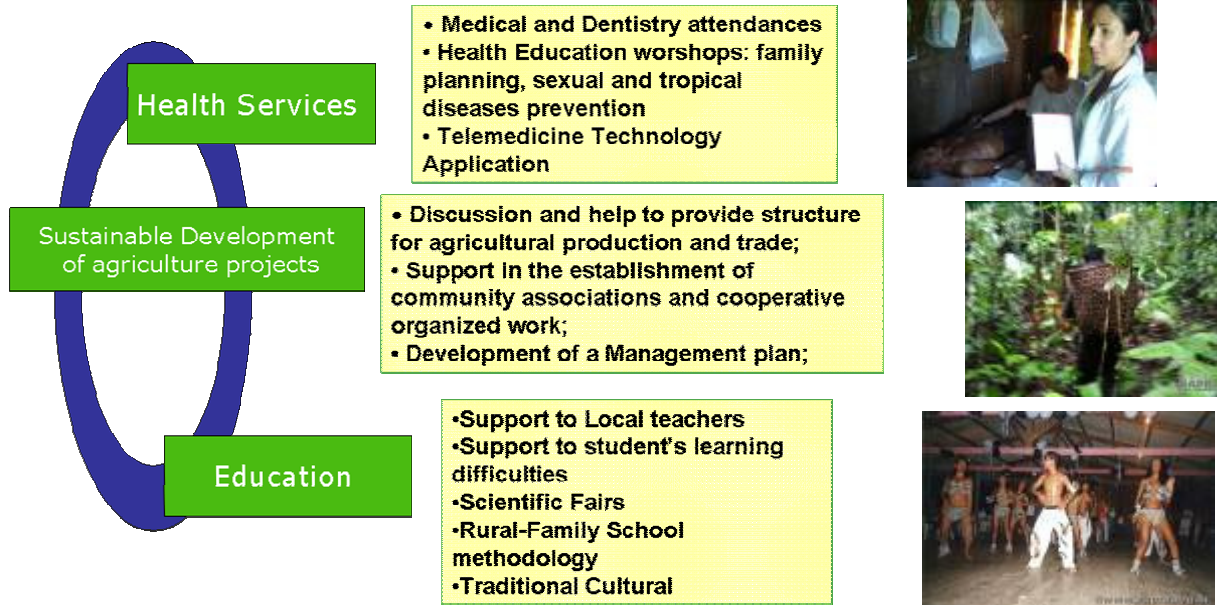
What's NAPRA?
